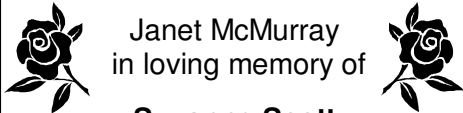

### The Fruit of the Spirit: GENTLENESS

"To be sure, Paul knew that when a person was controlled by the Spirit, that person was holy. He also knew that a person who lived in the Spirit lived in a loving way. Thus, he knew that the Old Testament moral guidelines and the teachings of Jesus on holiness, righteousness, and compassion would be confirmed by anyone who lived in the Spirit. This is important to remember. Paul's statement that the law of Moses cannot condemn anyone who lives in the Spirit shows that he knew that life in the Spirit would not and could not lead to moral anarchy (cf. v. 23)."
