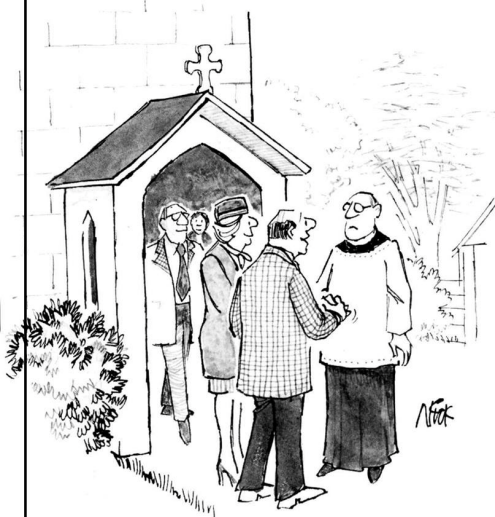

The Good Shepherd

"I am the good shepherd" (John 10:11) is the fourth of seven "I am" declarations of Jesus in John's Gospel. All seven point to the unique, divine identity and purpose of Jesus.

Sheep are totally defenceless and utterly dependent upon the shepherd. A good shepherd knows his sheep and watches over them, protecting and caring for them. Sheep are vulnerable in a dangerous world.

We, like sheep, need the good shepherd to guide us and watch over us.

Jesus is the Good Shepherd over all who have faith in him (John 3:16).

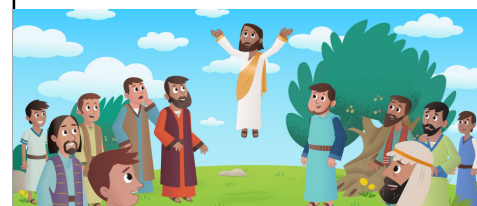
