Jesus is the Bread of Life

"I am the bread of life" Jesus said. He made seven "I am" assertions, all of them in the gospel of John, about his relationship to the world. Food is essential for life. Without it we would soon die. Spiritual food is even more important because we need it for eternity.

Jesus was at the peak of his popularity, and the crowd that followed him was loud and persistent. They wanted him to be their king because of what they saw as his ability to supply their material needs. They had no real interest in a relationship with God; they only wanted Jesus for what they could get out of him. In doing so they missed the opportunity to receive far more than mere bread.

Let us not make the same mistake.
